What is a
Provider and
Who
Determines
Who my
Provider will
be?

- A provider is an agency or person who is paid through your Medicaid Waiver to deliver services to you.
- A residential provider helps you in your home.
- A day habilitation provider is a place that you can go during the day for work or programming.
- A non-medical transportation provider takes you to and from your place of work or programming.
- You and/or your guardian decide who your providers will be.
